

Tribal Land Office Summer Internship Application

The Indian Land Tenure Foundation offers to grant up to \$10,000 for one (or up to \$15,000 for two) interns to work for your tribal land office in 2019. Interns should have completed their sophomore, junior or senior year of high school and have an interest in working on some aspect of tribal land management. The purpose of this program is to provide real-life experience to students, exposure to tribal land issues and the work of the tribal land office. This internship should extend over a 10 or 11-week period during the summer, with students committing to 400 hours throughout the period. Students **will be required** to keep a brief daily log of their internship activities, which will be submitted along with a two to five-page report to the Foundation detailing their activities and what they learned from the experience. In addition to the student reports, supervisors must complete a report summarizing intern activities as well as report upon challenges and/or successes to implementing the program in their community.
